There are three ways to renew your membership. The dues for 2024-25 are \$50.00. First, stop by the Post at 156A N. Dupont Hwy. and drop it off. While you are there, you can check out upcoming events and have a beverage of your choice. Next, mail it in to the above address with membership number in the notes on the check. Lastly, you can renew on-line at Mylegion.org, and it will be transmitted from National to the Post. If you currently have a muster number, you must stop by the Post and sign the new muster registry to keep this number. On September 1, 2024, any numbers that are not signed for will be left open for anyone to use. Moving forward, every September 1, you will need to resign the registry to keep your number. On the door card issue. You must stop by the Post to sign up for a door entry card. We will not send them in the mail. Also, if you lose your card, there will be a \$10.00 charge to receive a new one. 
If you suspect a veteran whom you know to be suicidal, please—make a resolute effort to persuade that veteran to seek professional help by calling the Veterans Crisis Line.
